Based on interview, the director stated that an out-of-state background check was never submitted or completed on this staff member. 2. Criminal records check required by KRS 199.896(19);

3. Criminal records check for any previous state of residence if the person resided outside the state of Kentucky in the last five (5) years; and

4. An address check of the Sex Offender Registry; and

(c) Not be left alone in the presence of a child until copies of the background checks in accordance with paragraph (b) of this subsection have been received by the licensee.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, one (1) staff (DOH: 9-1-16) indicated on their child abuse and neglect (CA/N) background check that they have resided outside of the state of Kentucky within the last five (5) years; however, the staff's file did not contain an out-of-state background check.
