General: Based on observation and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. A staff member hired on 10/07/19, did not have proof of the required education on file.

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

- (1) The premises shall be:
- (a) Suitable for the purpose intended;
- (b) Kept clean and in good repair;

Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The following items were observed:

- 1. The Orange 4 School-age Room contained several cobwebs in the corner by the ceiling.
- 2. The hall boy's bathroom contained a dusty ceiling vent.

580 - Floors, Walls, Ceilings Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

(9) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, in good repair, and constructed to be easily cleaned.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The following items were found:

- 1. The Blue 3 Preschool Room contained some areas of chipped paint below the bulletin board, on the wall next to the bookshelf, on the wall next to the home living area, and below the calendar on the wall.
- 2. The Orange 4 School-age Room contained two drywall patches on the wall near the writing center and one by the easel.
- 3. The front bathroom contained an area of torn drywall behind the bench.

650 - Toilet Not In Compliance

- (4) Each toilet shall:
- (a) Be kept in clean condition;
- (b) Be kept in good repair;
- (c) Be in a lighted room; and

Findings

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. A urinal was not working in the boy's hall bathroom. The urinal was covered with a bag. The urinal was not in good repair.

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The playground used by the younger children contained a red and blue slide that was located on the grass. The slide was approximately 2.5 feet tall. There was no protective surfacing other than the grass.

- (i) Parent at the parent's home or place of employment;
- (ii) Family physician; and
- (iii) Preferred hospital;
- c. The name of each person who is designated in writing to pick-up the child;
- d. The child's general health status and medical history including, if applicable:
- (i) Allergies;
- (ii) Restriction on the child's participation in activities with specific instructions from the child's parent or health professional; and
- (iii) Permission from the parent for third-party professional services in the child-care center;
- e. The name and phone number of each person to be contacted in an emergency involving or impacting the child;
- f. Authorization by the parent for the child-care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence;

Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The following items were missing from the children's enrollment paperwork:

- 1. A child enrolled on 9/16/19, was missing a physician's phone number in their file.
- 2. A child enrolled on 10/03/18, was missing a physician's name, phone number, and a preferred hospital in their file.
