This occurrence was observed by the Division of Regulated Child Care (DRCC) representative as she conducted a walk-through of the center. It was also observed on the video documentation with the staff in charge.</p> <p>Review of video footage captured from the same room on 04/04/2022 revealed a different staff member grabbed the forearm of a child and redirected the child by guiding his arm. The same staff member was also observed lifting a child into the air and placing the child on the changing table by grabbing one (1) of the child's arms between the wrist and elbow and the other arm between the elbow and shoulder.</p>

Review of video documentation of the One-Year-Old room from 04/04/2022 confirmed that rest time began at 11:45a.m. and children were still on their cots at 2:30p.m.</p>

 2. After toileting or assisting a child in toileting;
 3. Before and after diapering each child;
 4. After wiping or blowing a child's or own nose;
 5. After handling animals;
 6. After caring for a sick child;
 7. Before and after feeding a child or eating;
 8. Before dispensing medication;
 9. After smoking or vaping; and
 10. If possible, before administering first aid; and
- (d) Use hand sanitizer or hand-sanitizing wipes if liquid soap and warm running water are not available in accordance with paragraph (c) of this subsection. The staff shall wash the staff's hands as soon as practicable once liquid soap and warm running water are available.

Findings:

General: Review of the video documentation for the One-Year-Old room for 04/04/2022 revealed a staff member changed the diapers of three (3) children. The staff member kept a glove on one (1) hand through all diaper changes. The other hand remained bare. The staff member washed the children's hands; however, she was not observed going back to the sink to wash her own hands after returning the children to the area for play.

730 - Diaper Changing Area/Surface

- 6. Free of any items not used for diaper changing.

Findings:

General: Review of the video documentation for the One-Year-Old room for 04/04/2022 revealed a staff member changed the diapers of three (3) children. The staff member did not disinfect the diaper changing pad between the diaper changes.
