General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. A flat floor mop was located beside the sink in Classroom A.
- 2. A flat floor mop was located beside the sink in Classroom B.

3. A broom and dust pan was located beside the door in Classroom B.

4. Two brooms were located on the playground beside the door that leads to Classroom A.

The items mentioned were observed to be within reach and accessible to the children.

### Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. A blue square rug in Classroom A that contained stains; therefore, the rug was not kept clean.
- 2. A blue half circle rug in Classroom B that contained stains and debris; therefore, the rug was not kept clean.
- 3. The sink in the girls' restroom located in Classroom B contained green stains; therefore, the sink was not kept clean.

#### 650 - Toilet **Not In Compliance**

### 922 KAR 2:120. Section 10. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

- (4) Each toilet shall:
- (a) Be kept in clean condition;
- (b) Be kept in good repair;
- (c) Be in a lighted room; and

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found that the toilet bowl in the girls' restroom located in Classroom B contained stains; therefore, the toilet was not kept in clean condition.
