General: Based on Review of Documentation, two (2) caregivers hired on 3/8/10 and 2/18/14, each had an evaluation on file dated 3/21/17. A caregiver hired on 2/25/15, had an evaluation on file dated 3/16/17. Two (2) caregivers, hired on 12/9/13 and 6/16/14, had an evaluation on file dated 3/1/17. Also, two (2) caregivers hired on 4/4/17 and 4/4/16, did not have an evaluation on file.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, a caregiver hired on 4/4/16, had a TB test administered on 4/4/16, but was never read to show the results of the test.

# 410 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, a director hired on 6/12/06, lacked 2.25 hours of training; a caregiver hired on 3/8/10, lacked four (4) hours of training; a caregiver hired on 2/25/15, lacked five (5) hours of training; a caregiver hired on 4/4/16, lacked fifteen (15) hours of training. Also, a caregiver hired on 4/4/17, had not completed the Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma Training and completed the orientation training on 8/29/17 which was not within the first three (3) months of employment

- (2) Indoor and outdoor equipment shall:
- (a) Be clean, safe, and in good repair;
- (b) Meet the physical, developmental needs, and interests of children of different age groups;
- (c) Be free from sharp points or corners, splinters, protruding nails or bolts, loose or rusty parts, hazardous small parts, lead-based paint, poisonous material, and flaking or chalking paint; and
- (d) Be designed to guard against entrapment or situations that may cause strangulation.

#### Findings:

General: Based on Observation, a blue, vinyl square cushion had exposed foam in the one-year-olds' room. A turquoise Bumbo Seat was located in the infants' room and a second turquoise Bumbo Seat was located in the office. Each seat did not have restraint belts. A review of the Consumer Product Safety Commission recall information determined the Bumbo Seat was recalled in 2007, and instructed consumers to order a free repair kit which included a restraint belt and warning label. Interview determined the center was not aware of the recall.

General: Based on Observation, the posted schedule of daily activities indicated lunch was served 10:30 - 11:00 and the afternoon snack was 2:15 - 2:30 in the one-year-olds' room; therefore, the meals were not served every two (2) to three (3) hours.

- f. Authorization by the parent for the child-care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence;

General: Based on Review of Documentation, a child enrolled on 9/3/14, did not include the physician's contact information on the enrollment form.
