922 KAR 2:110. Section 5. Staff Requirements.

- (10) The minimum number of adult workers in a child-care center shall be sufficient to ensure that:
- (a) Minimum staff-to-child ratios in accordance with 922 KAR 2:120 are followed;
- (b) Each staff person under eighteen (18) years of age and each student trainee are under the direct supervision of a qualified staff person who meets the requirements of this section; and
- (c) Unless providing care with a qualified staff person, a person under the age of eighteen (18) shall not be counted as staff for the staff-to-child

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain regulatory requirements regarding staffing. Upon request, the child care director presented three employee files for employees with hire dates of 01/31/2017, 03/15/2017 and 05/02/2017. Review of the documentation revealed the employees were under the age of eighteen. Interviews with the staff revealed that the referenced minor employees had worked alone in the classroom on numerous occasions. Therefore, the minor staff was not under direct supervision of a qualified staff.

General: Based on Interviews, the child care director failed to assure compliance with regulatory requirements. A three-year-old child urinated on his clothing, the staff member dried the shorts but did not wash them. Then re-placed the soiled clothing back on the child for the remainder of the day.
