Due to the current declared public health emergency caused by the Novel Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19), licensed child care centers must operate under Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and public health guidelines, as mandated by 922 KAR 2:400E, to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

### Findings:

General: Based on observation, interview and review of documentation, the center failed to assure a child who is five (5) years of age or younger shall not wear a face mask due to the increased risk of suffocation and strangulation, in accordance with 922 KAR 2:400E Section 7(4). Surveyor observed a four-year-old child wear a face mask at the center. There was no medical documentation on file stating the child's need to wear a mask.
