General: Based on Observation, it was found that a plunger located in the bathroom off the Preschool Fine Motor classroom was accessible to the children.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found that the file for an employee hired on 9-1-08 contained evidence of a TB skin test that was read on 7-16-14. This date is not within the two (2) year timeframe required by the regulation.

- (14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 1/2) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and onehalf (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found that the ECE-TRIS record and file for an employee hired on 9-1-08 contained evidence of only twelve (12) hours of cabinet-approved training being completed during the last completed training year.
