<p>Findings: General: Based on observation, interview and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. On 7/13/2021, a five-year-old child was left asleep and unsupervised in Room 207 while the rest of the class and the staff member moved across the hall to Room 208. Based on interview and documentation, the child was left asleep on a rug behind a shelving unit in Room 207 for approximately 3 to 5 minutes unsupervised. Based on interview, at least one of the classroom doors was propped open to the hallway when the incident occurred. The staff member indicated that she was not aware that a child was left in Room 207 asleep. The school-age child may have been within range of voice of the staff member, but the staff member did not know the child's whereabouts; therefore, adequate supervision was not provided. Based on interview, the child was located by her parent when she picked up the child. The child did not sustain an injury. The child had a medical diagnosis on file of ADHD and autism.</p>
