922 KAR 2:120. Section 2. Child Care Services.

(3)(a) Each center shall maintain a child-care program that assures each child shall be:

- 1. Provided with adequate supervision at all times by a qualified staff person who ensures the child is:
- a. Within scope of vision and range of voice; or
- b. For a school-age child, within scope of vision or range of voice;

Findings:

General: Observation of the infant room at 11:47 a.m. on 3/29/2022 revealed the staff member exited the room leaving five (5) infants unsupervised for a short time. Interview with the staff member revealed the youngest infant in the room was twelve (12) weeks old.

180 - Allow Access Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 6. License Issuance.

(9) A child-care center shall allow the cabinet or its designee, another agency with regulatory authority, and a parent of an enrolled child unannounced access to the child-care center during the hours of operation.

Findings:

General: Interviews with multiple sources revealed parents are not allowed access to the child care center. The child care has a procedure where in the morning when a parent pulls up a staff member retrieves the child from the vehicle and takes them inside, then in the afternoon the parents are to call before arriving at the child care center and the child is escorted out to the vehicle.

285 - Notification of Center Closure

Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 13. Reports.

(6) The cabinet and the parent of a child enrolled in a child-care center shall receive notice as soon as practicable, and prior to, a child-care center's temporary or permanent closure.

Findings:

General: Observation of the child care center on 3/11/2022 revealed it was closed. Interview with a staff member revealed the child care center closed early on 3/9/2022, then was closed for the entire day on 3/10/2022 and 3/11/2022. Review of Division of Regulated Child Care records revealed the closure was not reported.

1070 - Bottle Feeding Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 3. General Requirements.

- (11) While bottle feeding a child, the:
- (a) Child shall be held; and
- (b) Bottle or beverage container shall not be:
- 1. Propped;
- 2. Left in the mouth of a sleeping child; or
- 3. Heated in a microwave.

Findings:

General: Observation of the infant room revealed an infant consuming a bottle while lying in a crib. Interview with a staff member confirmed the child in the crib was an infant.
