General: Based on Review of Documentation, three (3) staff did not have current TB verification in their files. The hire dates are 8/18/14, 1/12/15 and 8/25/14

922 KAR 2:110. Section 5. Staff Requirements. (14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following: (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment; (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and		
(c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-		
half (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.		
Findings: General: Based on Review of Documentation, five (5) staff did not complete the mandatory fifteen (15) hours of training. The hire dates for those staff are 8/1 9/8/14 and 8/18/14. Based on review, seven (7) employees did not complete the madatory orientation training. The hire dates for those staff are 9/19/16, 11/1 11/11/16, 9/12/16, and 1/23/17. Training was verified through ECE-TRIS along with the employees files.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found that two (2) children's files out of ten (10) children's files reviewed did not contain evidence of information regarding the parent's preferred hospital.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, three (3) staff did not have a Professional Development Plan in their file. Their hire dates were 8/12/09, 9/14/15, vand 8/18/14.

1140 - Fire Drills

Findings:
