General: Based on review of documentation, the following was found:

- 1. Staff person hired 11/11/2020, did not have the results of or evidence of the application for a CAN check on file in the facility. The staff person is listed as a substitute and does not work alone with the children.
- 2. Staff hired 7/1/12, 11/5/18, 8/24/2020 and 11/11/2020 did not have evidence of completing the required training for the re-opening of child care facilities. A review of ECE-TRIS records supports the information found during the survey.
