#### Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, the child care center failed to comply with staffing requirements. Observation of the Toddler classroom revealed one (1) staff and eleven (11) children for less than two (2) minutes. Interview with staff revealed the youngest child in the classroom was one-year-old. The staff-to-child ratio was exceeded by five (5) children based on the youngest child in the classroom.
