Findings:

General: Based on observation, an inspection of the outdoor play area found a tall plastic climber sitting next to the fence. There was not an adequate fall zone around the piece of equipment. In addition the mulch was sparse under the climber. Also, the mulch under an arched yellow metal climber, yellow monkey bars and a grey metal chin up bar was sparse.

Findings:

General: Based on interview, it was found that mats used for napping in the older one-year-old room are disinfected every Friday. The mats were observed stored on their end side by side in the closet. There was no barrier between each mat to keep them from touching. This manner of storing mats that are not sanitized daily or have a barrier between each mat allows for cross contamination of germs. Transportation
