- f. Authorization by the parent for the child-care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence;

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. A child enrolled on 8/13/18, did not have a preferred hospital listed on the enrollment paperwork.
