General: Based on Review of Documentation, there were two (2) staff listed as substitutes. One (1) of the substitutes had a hire date of 1/16/16. The date of the signature of this staff person on the child abuse and neglect check was 2/17/16. The application for the results of a child abuse and neglect check is required to be submitted within five (5) days of hire. In addition this same staff person did not have the results of a criminal records check nor was there documentation available for review to verify that the application of the criminal records check had been submitted. A review of ECE-Tris records found that this staff person's information was not in the system and verification of the completion of orientation training could not be confirmed. An interview with the staff person in charge indicated that this staff person had been signed up twice to take the orientation training but did not complete the training.

- e. The name and phone number of each person to be contacted in an emergency situation involving or impacting the child;
- f. Authorization by the parent for the child-care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence;

General: Based on Review of Documentation, there was one (1) child's enrollment information that did not have a preferred hospital listed. The parent listed a hospital they did not want their child taken to in case of an emergency.
