General: Based on Observation, staff hired 4/24/17, who was present at the center, had no records on file. Staff hired 2/28/17, only had a TB skin test and education verification on file

400 - CPR/First Aid Coverage Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (3) For a child-care center licensed for infant, toddler, or preschool-age children, at least one (1) person on duty and present with the children shall be currently certified by a cabinet-approved training agency in the following skills:
- (a) Infant and child cardiopulmonary resuscitation; and
- (b) Infant and child first aid.
- (4) For a child-care center licensed for school-age children, at least one (1) person on duty and present with the children shall be currently certified by a cabinet-approved training agency in the following skills:
- (a) Adult cardiopulmonary resuscitation; and
- (b) First aid.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation and interview, staff hired 5/16/13, was the only staff present at the center with current first aid and CPR certification. Staff hired 5/16/13, stated she left the center from 11:30 am until 12:30 pm on 2/28/17. Therefore, no staff was present with current first aid and CPR certification.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, there were two (2) brown spots, twelve (12) inches in diameter, that covered a ceiling tile. Also, five (5) ceiling tiles had a large brown spot in the preschool room, two (2) ceiling tiles had a large brown spot in the one-year-olds' room, a ceiling tile was filled with what appeared to be water and swayed down. In addition, a ceiling tile was missing in the school-age room. Interview determined the roof had a leak.
