- 1. Child abuse or neglect check using the central registry in accordance with 922 KAR 1:470;
- 2. Criminal records check required by KRS 199.896(19);
- 3. Criminal records check for any previous state of residence if the person resided outside the state of Kentucky in the last five (5) years; and
- 4. An address check of the Sex Offender Registry; and
- (c) Not be left alone in the presence of a child until copies of the background checks in accordance with paragraph (b) of this subsection have been received by the licensee.

# Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, the following was found: 1. One (1) staff person with a rehire date of 8/15/16 had a criminal records check (CRC) application that was dated 8/31/16 and a child abuse/neglect check (CAN) that had been signed by the staff person on 8/30/16. The staff person in charge stated that she had not yet submitted this documentation for processing; therefore, they were not submitted within the regulatory timeframe. 2. One (1) staff person (hire date: 7/5/16) had a CRC that was dated 7/7/16. 3. One (1) staff person (hire date: 9/7/16) had a CRC application in their file dated 8/27/16; however, it had not been mailed for processing.

#### Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, and interview, the following was found:

1. One (1) staff person (hire date: 10/7/13) did not contain evidence or results of the child abuse/neglect check (CAN). The staff person in charge stated that this documentation must have been misplaced.

2. The hire dates for four (4) employees were not available in the files. The staff person in charge looked at internal documentation during the visit and then identified 7/5/16, 9/7/16, 8/31/16 and 9/6/16 as their hire dates.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, two (2) staff (hire dates: 8/31/16 and 9/6/16) did not have educational documentation on file.

- (5) The child-care center shall keep a written record of the administration of medication, including:
- (a) Time of each dosage;
- (b) Date;
- (c) Amount;
- (d) Name of staff person giving the medication;
- (e) Name of the child; and
- (f) Name of the medication.

#### Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation and interview, this regulatory requirement was not met. A review of medication permission slips posted inside a cabinet door in the two (2) year old classroom revealed the following:

1. Three (3) dates where a parent/guardian had given written permission for a medication to be administered; however, there was no documentation to show if the medication had been given. The staff documentation section on the bottom of the form had been left blank. The staff person in charge reviewed the documentation with the surveyor during the visit; however, did not have an explanation of why this occurred.

2. One (1) parent had given written permission for their child to receive lbuprofen on 6/21/16. The specific instructions stated "as needed for teething". This medication procedure does not meet regulatory requirements for the administration of medications because specific times must be listed.

General: Based on Observation and interview, this regulatory requirement was not met. At the time of the visit the surveyor observed children eating bananas and apple juice for AM snack. Bananas and apple juice are from the same food group; therefore, food items from two (2) of the required groups were not served. The staff person in charge stated that she was not aware of this regulatory requirement.
