General: Based on Observation, it was found that a plunger was by the toilet in the Preschool bathroom, thus making it accessible to the children.

### Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found that the file for an employee hired on 12-1-16 contained evidence of a TB skin test that was read on 9-30-15. This date is not within the two (2) year timeframe required by the regulation.

The medication box was found to contain a tube of prescription Nystatin Ointment and nine (9) tubes of diaper cream. An unlocked cabinet in the Toddler classroom contained an unlocked medication box. The medication box was found to contain multiple containers of diaper cream and sunscreen.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found that two (2) children's files out of twelve (12) children's files reviewed contained immunization certificates that were no longer current as of 8-5-17 and 9-10-17. Both children had been enrolled for more than thirty (30) days.
