922 KAR 2:110. Section 2. General.

- (8) If a director, employee, volunteer, or any person with supervisory or disciplinary control over, or having unsupervised contact with a child in care is named as the alleged perpetrator in a child abuse or neglect report accepted by the cabinet in accordance with 922 KAR 1:330, the individual shall be removed from direct contact with a child in care:
  - (a) For the duration of the family-in-need-of-services assessment or investigation; and
- (b) Pending completion of the administrative appeal process for a cabinet substantiation of child abuse or neglect in accordance with 922 KAR 1:320 or 922 KAR 1:480.

#### Findings:

265 - Health, Safety, Comfort

General: Based on Observation, and interview, two (2) staff that are currently under investigation by the cabinet for abuse/neglect, continued to have direct contact with the children at the facility after being notified on 2/12/14 by the DCBS Worker investigating allegations at the facility that this could not happen. The surveyor observed these two (2) staff working in the infant classroom during the investigation on 2/14/14. The staff person in charge acknowledged being notified of this regulatory requirement on 2/12/14; however, stated that she did not have available staff to replace them.
