General: Based on review of documentation, KAR 2:090 available for review was from 2013, the regulation has been updated since this date. Additionally, KAR 2:280 was not available for review.

345 - Staff Evaluation Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 10. Director Requirements and Responsibilities.

- (1) A director shall:
- (j) Assess each staff person's interaction with children in care and classroom performance through an annual written performance evaluation;

# Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, one staff member had a blank evaluation in their personnel file. Additionally, one staff member did not have an employee evaluation on file for review.

#### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, a staff member hired 5/3/2021 did not have proof of educational qualifications in their personnel file.

520 - Inaccessible Items Not In Compliance

#### 922 KAR 2:120. Section 3. General Requirements.

- (7) The following shall be inaccessible to a child in care:
- (a) Toxic cleaning supplies, poisons, and insecticides;
- (b) Matches, cigarettes, lighters, and flammable liquids; and
- (c) Personal belongings and medications of staff.

#### Findings:

General: Based on observation, a lock under a sink in the Tugboat classroom was not in working order. The sink housed Lysol disinfectant spray with a warning label that stated, "Keep out of reach of children." This item was accessible to the children in care. Also, cabinet in the Sailboats classroom was unlocked; the cabinet housed a gallon of bleach.

# 580 - Floors, Walls, Ceilings Not In Compliance

# 922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

(9) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, in good repair, and constructed to be easily cleaned.

#### Findings:

General: Based on observation,

- 1.) Several areas of drywall were exposed in the Starfish classroom.
- 2.) The Dolphin's classroom contained several areas of missing and chipping paint.
- 3.) The wall near the door of the Sailboats classroom was scuffed with dirt and grime.
- 4.) Paint was chipping on the windowsill of the Sunfish classroom.

# 922 KAR 2:120. Section 10. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

- (4) Each toilet shall:
- (a) Be kept in clean condition;
- (b) Be kept in good repair;
- (c) Be in a lighted room; and

General: Based on observation, the toilet in the Sailboats classroom was not flushed; fecal matter and urine were present.

General: Based on review of documentation, two children were not signed in in the Starfish Classroom.

1195 - Fire Drills Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 3. General Requirements.

- (12) A fire drill shall be:
- (a) Conducted during hours of operation at least monthly; and
- (b) Documented.
- (13) An earthquake drill and a tornado drill shall be:
- (a) Conducted during hours of operation at least quarterly; and
- (b) Documented.

General: Based on review of documentation, there was no written evidence documenting that a Fire drill had been practiced in the month of April 2021.

- (c) Each plan of correction submitted by the child-care center to the cabinet during the current licensure year;
- (d) Information on the Kentucky Consumer Product Safety Program and the program's Web site as specified in KRS 199.897;
- (e) A description of services provided by the child-care center, including:
- 1. Current rates for child care; and
- 2. Each service charged separately and in addition to the basic rate for child care;
- (f) Minimum staff-to-child ratios and group size established in 922 KAR 2:120; and
- (g) Daily planned program.

# Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the lesson plans in the Starfish, Minnows, and Sailboat classrooms were not dated; there was no evidence to indicate that the posted plan was being implemented within the classroom. Additionally, the lesson plan in the Tugboat classroom was not current; the posted plan was dated 4/19/2021.
