- (5) An individual described in subsection (4) of this section shall:
- (a) Submit to background checks described in paragraph (b) of this subsection;
- (b) May be employed or work with a child on a probationary basis for up to ninety (90) calendar days, pending completion of a:
- 1. Child abuse or neglect check using the central registry in accordance with 922 KAR 1:470;
- 2. Criminal records check required by KRS 199.896(19);
- 3. Criminal records check for any previous state of residence if the person resided outside the state of Kentucky in the last five (5) years; and
- 4. An address check of the Sex Offender Registry; and
- (c) Not be left alone in the presence of a child until copies of the background checks in accordance with paragraph (b) of this subsection have been received by the licensee.

## Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, there were two (2) employees who had other states listed on their CAN checks. Neither employee had results from an out of state background check in their personnel files. The staff person in charge stated that she did not realize that she needed to have those checks completed for each employee. One of the employees was present and was working with another staff person.

### Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, an employee with a hire date of 9/15/15 had a TB test result in their file dated for 3/17/16. There was no proof of negative TB test results in their file on or before their date of hire.

#### 922 KAR 2:110. Section 5. Staff Requirements.

(14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:

- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

#### Findings

General: Based on Review of Documentation, an employee with a hire date of 9/15/15 did not complete the orientation training until 7/6/16. This information was confirmed through the ECE-Tris system.
