- (b) The child care staff member shall:
- 1. Have no more than ninety (90) calendar days from the date of payment pursuant to subsections (2) and (3) of this section to submit the child care staff member's fingerprints at an authorized collection site for NBCP; and
- 2. Present the DCC-504 and driver's license or other government-issued photo identification to the designated agent at an authorized collection site prior to fingerprint submission.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, staff person hired 10/1/19, did not have the results of the application for a criminal background check through the NBCP on file in the facility. A review of KARES records supports the information found during the survey. The KARES cite indicated that the application was closed out 5/29/19, because fingerprints were never taken. The staff person was not observed alone with children.
