General: Based on observation, the following was found:

- 1. There were several outlets uncovered in the toddler classroom.
- 2. The kitchen door was propped open during the survey visit. There was food cooking on the stove and there was an unlocked sink cabinet that contained Cascade Pods, dishwashing liquid and floor cleaner.

General: Based on review of documentation, staff hired on 09/20/17 did not have current documentation on file from a health care professional stating that she was free of active tuberculosis.

General: Based on review of documentation, there were no staff at all that were certified in CPR/First Aid. Certified CPR/First Aid staff certificates on file had expired 01/22/19.

- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and

General: Based on Review of documentation, the following was found:

- 1. Staff person hired on 05/15/17 had only five (5) hours of cabinet approved training on file.
- 2. Staff person hired on 09/20/17 had not completed Orientation I and II, Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma or the fifteen (15) hours of cabinet approved training.
- 3. Staff person hired on 09/23/16 had only seven (7) hours of cabinet approved training on file.
- 4. Staff person hired on 12/01/15 did not have any cabinet approved training hours on file.

- 1. Two (2) siblings enrolled on 02/13/15 did not have the emergency authorization signed by the parent/guardian and did not have physician's contact information or preferred hospital listed on file.
- 2. Child enrolled on 09/24/18 did not have physician's contact information listed on file.
