For a school-age child, within scope of vision or range of voice;</p> <p>Findings: Based on interviews and review of video footage dated 07/21/21 and 07/22/21, nine (9), two-year-old children were left alone in the preschool-1 room for an undetermined amount of time during naptime. In addition, interviews and review of video dated 07/26/21 determined two (2) caregivers left nine (9), two-year-old children alone in the preschool-1 room on 07/26/21. The children were left alone for approximately twenty-seven (27) minutes, ten (10) minutes, seven (7) minutes, five (5) minutes and four (4) minutes, between 12:30 p.m. and 2:00 p.m., on 07/26/21. Interviews determined it was common practice for caregivers to daily socialize in the hallway, near their classrooms, during the children's naptime.</p>
