General: Based on observation, the surveyor discovered a sink was missing a portion of the handle for the hot water; therefore, the premises was not kept in good repair. The sink was located in the restroom between Room 213C and Room 214B.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, during a tour of the 233A Classroom, the surveyor discovered a portable sink/self-contained handwashing station was installed in the classroom. Upon inspection, the surveyor discovered that the water supply for the sink is supplied from a container of water placed under the sink; therefore, the water supply is not potable as required. Staff stated the sink is used for children to wash their hands after art projects. Staff stated they only use the sink for this purpose and that children typically wash their hands in the restroom located outside of the classroom. Staff-in-charge confirmed the sink was purchased and installed to provide a way for the children to wash their hands in the classroom when participating in art projects.
