Findings:

General: Based on observation, the Step 2 green and tan climber with a slide did not contain an adequate amount of pea gravel around the apparatus. There were areas that the pea gravel was sparse and weeds/grass were growing through the surfacing. The Step 2 climber with a slide was approximately 5.5 feet tall.

### 820 - Indoor/Outdoor Equipment

### 922 KAR 2:120. Section 11. Toys and Furnishings.

(2) Indoor and outdoor equipment shall:

(a) Be clean, safe, and in good repair;

(b) Meet the physical, developmental needs, and interests of children of different age groups;

(c) Be free from sharp points or corners, splinters, protruding nails or bolts, loose or rusty parts, hazardous small parts, lead-based paint,

poisonous material, and flaking or chalking paint; and

(d) Be designed to guard against entrapment or situations that may cause strangulation.

## Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met.

1. A Step 2 green and tan climber with a slide (located in the outdoor play area used by the older children) contained a broken section of plastic on the side of the apparatus. The broken piece of plastic was sharp.

2. A small tricycle, located in the outdoor play area and used by the younger children, contained a cracked plastic wheel cover.
