General: Based on review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. A staff hired on 7/01/2022, did not have proof of education on file.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. Three staff did not have documentation of CPR and First Aid training. These staff were hired on 8/05/2012, 7/14/2021, and 8/11/2020. The ECE-TRIS system and the staff files were reviewed.

- e. The name and phone number of each person to be contacted in an emergency involving or impacting the child;
- f. Authorization by the parent for the child-care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. A child's file was missing a preferred hospital. This area was left blank on the enrollment form. The date of enrollment for this child is 09/02/2022.
