- (a) Suitable for the purpose intended;
- (b) Kept clean and in good repair;

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. A blue square rug located in Classroom 1 contained dirt and food; therefore, the rug was not kept clean.
- 2. A square farm animal rug located in Classroom 1 contained green playdoh dried on the "chicken square"; therefore, the rug was not kept clean.
- 3. A vent on the back wall located in Classroom 1 had a coating of dust; therefore, the vent was not kept clean.
- 4. A mirror that was falling off of the wall in Classroom 1 was not secure and exposed paint chipping; therefore, the mirror and the wall were not kept in good repair.



690 - Sink Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 12. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

- (3) A sink shall be:
- (a) Located in or immediately adjacent to toilet rooms;
- (b) Equipped with hot and cold running water that allows for hand washing;
- (c) Equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit;
- (d) Equipped with liquid soap;
- (e) Equipped with hand-drying blower or single use disposable hand drying material;
- (f) Equipped with an easily cleanable waste receptacle; and
- (g) Immediately adjacent to a changing area used for infants and toddlers.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. The hot water temperature at the sink in Classroom B measured approximately 70 degrees Fahrenheit.
- 2. The hot water temperature at the sink in Classroom 1 measured approximately 82 degrees Fahrenheit.
- 3. The hot water temperature at the sink in Classroom 2 measured approximately 71 degrees Fahrenheit.
- 4. The hot water temperature at the sink in the restroom beside Classroom 2 measured approximately 80 degrees Fahrenheit.

Therefore, the hot water was not a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit.
