922 KAR 2:090. Section 6. License Issuance.

- (5) An individual described in subsection (4) of this section shall:
- (a) Submit to background checks described in paragraph (b) of this subsection;
- (b) May be employed or work with a child on a probationary basis for up to ninety (90) calendar days, pending completion of a:
- 1. Child abuse or neglect check using the central registry in accordance with 922 KAR 1:470;
- 2. Criminal records check required by KRS 199.896(19);
- 3. Criminal records check for any previous state of residence if the person resided outside the state of Kentucky in the last five (5) years; and
- 4. An address check of the Sex Offender Registry; and
- (c) Not be left alone in the presence of a child until copies of the background checks in accordance with paragraph (b) of this subsection have been received by the licensee.

Findings:

General: Based on a review of documentation, a volunteer, start date 6-6-16, did not have a criminal records check and a child abuse and neglect check on file. A volunteer, start date 4-14-16, did not have a child abuse and neglect check on file.

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345 - Driver Requirements Not In Compliance

- (18) A driver of a vehicle transporting a child for a center shall:
- (a) Be at least twenty-one (21) years old;
- (b) Complete:
- 1. The background checks as described in 922 KAR 2:110; and
- 2. An annual check of the:
 - a. Kentucky driver history records in accordance with KRS 186.018; or
- b. Driver history records through the state transportation agency that issued the driver's license;
- (c) Hold a current driver's license which has not been suspended or revoked during the last five (5) years; and

General: Based on a review of documentation and interview, a staff member/driver, hired 1-1-04, had no driver's history on file.

(9) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, in good repair, and constructed to be easily cleaned.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the ceiling tile above the single sink was wet and had brown marks in classroom #1. The ceiling tile above the single sink was wet and sagged in classroom #5. Interview with staff determined they were unaware of what caused the wet tiles. Also, the wall had peeling paint and peeling drywall paper in the back left corner of classroom #4

580 - Toilet Room Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 10. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

- (2) A toilet room shall:
 - (a) 1. Be provided for each gender; or
 - 2. A plan shall be implemented to use the same toilet room at separate times;
 - (b) Have a supply of toilet paper; and
 - (c) Be cleaned and sanitized daily.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the exhaust vent fan covers had an accumulation of dust in classroom #1's restroom, the restroom between classroom #2 and classroom #3, and the restroom between classroom #4 and classroom #5.

- (c) Be free from sharp points or corners, splinters, protruding nails or bolts, loose or rusty parts, hazardous small parts, lead-based paint, poisonous material, and flaking or chalking paint; and
- (d) Be designed to guard against entrapment or situations that may cause strangulation.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, vehicle HS46 did not have a functional emergency break and was used to transport children. A blue vinyl couch had a three (3) inch whole and foam exposed in the middle of the seat cushion in classroom #2.

- (a) Be licensed and approved by the cabinet or its designee prior to transporting a child;
- (b) Have a written plan that details the type of transportation, staff schedule, transportation schedule, and transportation route; and
- (c) Have written policies and procedures, including emergency procedures practiced monthly by staff who transports children.

Findings

General: Based on a review of documentation, the center only practices emergency evacuation of buses when the bus is used. The only documented evacuation practice in the last year was for 6-20-17. Interview with staff determined the evacuations drills are only conducted if a transport is used in that month.
