General: Based on observation, interview and review of documentation, a five (5) year old male child was left alone on the outdoor fenced playground on 6/13/19. A review of the center's recorded video revealed the child was alone and unsupervised for seven (7) minutes when two (2) staff members failed to count children under their care when they returned inside the classroom. A review of the center's safety guidelines stated: The following guidelines will be followed by all Children's Services staff: No child will ever be left alone, unsupervised or out of staff/child ratios. Upon arrival and departure, a staff person greets or acknowledges each child as he/she comes and goes.

## 350 - Health, Safety, Comfort

## Findings:

General: Based on observation, interview and review of documentation, a five (5) year old male child was left alone on the outdoor fenced playground on 6/13/19. The center's recorded video determined at 3:57 pm the children lined up on the playground to go inside the childcare center. The five (5) male child was seen on the video, alone on the playground, walk towards the door at 4:02 pm, but return to play. The five (5) year old child was seen on the recorded video a second time, run from behind a piece of play equipment to the door at 4:04 pm, and was not seen on the recorded video again. Interviews revealed the five (5) year old male child had a bowel movement while alone on the playground on 6/13/19. The child was alone and unsupervised for seven (7) minutes.
