(11) A child who does not sleep shall be permitted to play quietly and be visually supervised.

Findings:

General: Based on interviews, the family child care provider failed to visually supervise a child who was awake. The cabinet representatives conducted an onsite investigation on 4/13/18. Interviews revealed that on 4/11/18 at approximately 4:00 p.m., the provider was carrying an infant from the play room to the enclosed deck area for snack when the provider realized the infant she was carrying had a soiled diaper. The provider stated that she laid the child down in the living room floor in order to change the child's diaper when she asked a five-year-old female if she would like to help her. The provider stated the child went into the play room and got her four (4) month old sister out of the swing and fell with her at the steps as she was carrying her. The provider stated that she did not see the incident occur, but heard a loud thump. Based on interviews, the child fell as she approached the two (2) steps. She dropped her four (4) month old sister and fell on top of her which resulted in the infant receiving a "buckle fracture" to her tibia. Interviews revealed the four (4) month old was in the swing awake while the other children had transitioned to the living room and deck area. It is unknown exactly how long the infant was left unsupervised before the infant's sister got her out of the swing.

Findings:

General: Based on interviews, the family child care provider failed to provide for the health, safety, and comfort of a child enrolled. The cabinet representatives conducted an onsite investigation on 4/13/18. Interviews revealed that on 4/11/18 at approximately 4:00 p.m., the provider was carrying an infant from the play room to the enclosed deck area for snack when the provider realized the infant she was carrying had a soiled diaper. The provider stated that she laid the child down in the living room floor in order to change the child's diaper when she asked a five-year-old female if she would like to help her. The provider stated the child went into the play room and got her four (4) month old sister out of the swing and fell with her at the steps as she was carrying her. The provider stated that she did not see the incident occur, but heard a loud thump. Based on interviews, the child fell as she approached the two (2) steps. She dropped her four (4) month old sister and fell on top of her which resulted in the infant receiving a "buckle fracture" to her tibia. Parent interview found that they were unclear if their child was told to get her sister from the play room of if their child had asked if she could get her sister from the play room. Interviews revealed the four (4) month old was in the swing awake while the other children had transitioned to the living room and deck area. It is unknown exactly how long the infant was left unsupervised before the infant's sister got her out of the swing.
