#### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation presented, the surveyor did not find written annual performance evaluations for three (3) staff (DOH: 08/25/11, 12/21/07, and 11/27/17). Through interview, staff confirmed that the written annual performance evaluations were not completed. During interview, staff stated the center was closed from March 2020 until March 2021.

General: Based on review of documentation presented, the surveyor found that the posted program of activities was dated 01/06/2020 through 01/10/2020; therefore, the lesson plan was not updated as required.

- (3) A sink shall be:
- (a) Located in or immediately adjacent to toilet rooms;
- (b) Equipped with hot and cold running water that allows for hand washing;
- (c) Equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit;
- (d) Equipped with liquid soap;
- (e) Equipped with hand-drying blower or single use disposable hand drying material;
- (f) Equipped with an easily cleanable waste receptacle; and
- (g) Immediately adjacent to a changing area used for infants and toddlers.

# Findings:

General: Based on observation during a tour of the center, the surveyor found that the water temperature in the classroom sink and the sinks in the girls' and boys' restrooms located by the gymnasium was kept at 73 degrees; therefore, the sinks was not equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit.

During interview, staff stated they had asked school maintenance for help with the sinks several times.
