Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found the fire marshal report was dated 8/5/19. During interview, staff stated that the secretary was out of the office; therefore, staff did not have access to a more current fire marshal report for the surveyor to review.

- (1) Child-care center staff:
- (b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:
- 1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or
- 2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor discovered the following:

- 1. A staff's personnel file (DOH:8/25/2011) contained a negative tuberculin result that was no longer current after 7/23/2020.
- 2. A staff's personnel file (DOH:12/21/2007) contained a negative tuberculin result that was no longer current after 6/20/2020.

Therefore, the child-care center failed to show proof that the employees were free of active tuberculosis or provide a copy of a negative tuberculin result.



410 - CPR/First Aid Coverage Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (3) For a child-care center licensed for infant, toddler, or preschool-age children, at least one (1) person on duty and present with the children shall be currently certified by a cabinet-approved training agency in the following skills:
- (a) Infant and child cardiopulmonary resuscitation; and
- (b) Infant and child first aid.
- (4) For a child-care center licensed for school-age children, at least one (1) person on duty and present with the children shall be currently certified by a cabinet-approved training agency in the following skills:
- (a) Adult cardiopulmonary resuscitation; and
- (5) Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and first aid training shall be in addition to the fifteen (15) clock hours requirement in subsection (16) of this section.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor discovered that the CPR/ First Aid certificates located in the files of two (2) staff (DOH: 8/25/2011 & 12/21/2007) were issued by the National CPR Foundation. The National CPR Foundation is not a cabinet-approved training source; therefore, the child-care center failed to ensure that at least one (1) person on duty and present with the children had cabinet-approved certification in CPR/First Aid. Staff stated during interview that she was not aware that this agency was not a cabinet approved training agency. The two (2) staff are the only two (2) staff hired at the child care center.

- (a) Meet the staff requirements of this administrative regulation; and
- (b) Provide the required documentation to verify compliance with this administrative regulation.

Findings:

General: Based on interview, staff confirmed that the child care center does not have two (2) qualified staff persons who are substitutes.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor was unable to locate the Emergency Preparedness Plan for the child-care center. During interview, staff stated she remembers completing the plan; however, she could not locate the Emergency Preparedness Plan for the surveyor to review.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor discovered the following:

- 1. The personnel file for staff (DOH:8/25/2011) contained a professional development plan dated 8/7/18.
- 2. The personnel file for staff (DOH:12/21/2007) contained a professional development plan dated 8/7/19.

Therefore, the surveyor was unable to determine if the required annual professional development plans were completed. Staff stated during interview that she thought the professional development plans were complete; however, she was unable to provide a copies for review during the surveyor's visit.

- (c) Each plan of correction submitted by the child-care center to the cabinet during the current licensure year;
- (d) Information on the Kentucky Consumer Product Safety Program and the program's Web site as specified in KRS 199.897;
- (e) A description of services provided by the child-care center, including:
- 1. Current rates for child care; and
- 2. Each service charged separately and in addition to the basic rate for child care;
- (f) Minimum staff-to-child ratios and group size established in 922 KAR 2:120; and
- (g) Daily planned program.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor was unable to locate the statement of deficiency or the plan of correction for the current licensure year. During interview, staff reviewed the documents posted in the classroom and stated that they forgot to print or post the statement of deficiency and the plan of correction; therefore, the child-care center failed to post the statement of deficiency and plan of correction for the current licensure year as required.
