- (1) Child-care center staff:
- (a) Hired after January 1, 2009, who have supervisory power over a minor and are not enrolled in secondary education, shall have a:
- 1. High school diploma:
- 2. GED or qualifying documentation from a comparable educational entity; or
- 3. Commonwealth Child Care Credential as described in 922 KAR 2:250;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulatory requirements. Upon request, the child care center director failed to provide documented evidence of a high school diploma for staff with a hire date of 08/01/18. The document presented did not indicate if the staff person "graduated" high school.

410 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulatory requirements. Upon request, the child care director failed to provide documented evidence of one and one-half (1 1/2) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training for staff with a hire date of 01/03/17. The certificate provided was more than five (5) years old and had expired. In addition, there was no documented evidence provided for staff with hire dates 08/01/12 and 08/05/16 that would indicate the staff completed fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment.

- 2. Glass;
- 3. Rubbish; and
- 4. Flammable materials;

Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain an outdoor play area in accordance with regulatory requirements. Observation of the outdoor play area revealed trash and debris. Interview with the child care center director revealed it was the responsibility of staff to clean the play area after each visit.

750 - Playground Conditions **Not In Compliance**

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

- (20) An outdoor play area shall be:
- (d) Safe from foreseeable hazard;
- (e) Well drained;
- (f) Well maintained;
- (g) In good repair; and

820 - Indoor/Outdoor Equipment

(h) Visible to staff at all times.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the child care center failed to maintain an outdoor play area in accordance with regulatory requirements. Observation of the outdoor play area revealed loosely placed fabric under the protective surface. The fabric was placed in a manner that presented a foreseeable "tripping" hazard for the children when they played.

Equipment Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 11. Toys and Furnishings.

- (2) Indoor and outdoor equipment shall:
- (a) Be clean, safe, and in good repair;
- (b) Meet the physical, developmental needs, and interests of children of different age groups;
- (c) Be free from sharp points or corners, splinters, protruding nails or bolts, loose or rusty parts, hazardous small parts, lead-based paint, poisonous material, and flaking or chalking paint; and
- (d) Be designed to guard against entrapment or situations that may cause strangulation.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the child care center failed to maintain equipment in accordance with regulatory requirements. Observation of the outdoor play area revealed tricycles without good repair. The toys contained sharp points or corners, loose or rusty parts and chipping, flaking paint.
