General: Based on Observation, the child care center failed to maintain the premises in accordance with regulatory requirements. Observation of the bathroom revealed a sink with the water temperature registering one hundred twenty-five (125) degrees Fahrenheit.

(1) A child-care center shall maintain:

(b) A written record for each child:

1. Completed and signed by the child's parent;

2. Retained on file on the first day the child attends the child-care center; and

3. To contain:

a. Identifying information about the child, which includes, at minimum, the child's name, address, and date of birth;

b. Contact information to enable a person in charge to contact the child's:

(i) Parent at the parent's home or place of employment;

(ii) Family physician; and

(iii) Preferred hospital;

c. The name of each person who is designated in writing to pick-up the child;

d. The child's general health status and medical history including, if applicable:

(i) Allergies;

(ii) Restriction on the child's participation in activities with specific instructions from the child's parent or health professional; and

(iii) Permission from the parent for third-party professional services in the child-care center;

e. The name and phone number of each person to be contacted in an emergency situation involving or impacting the child;

f. Authorization by the parent for the child-care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence;

#### Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, and interview, the child care center failed to maintain children's records in accordance with regulatory requirements. Review of ten (10) children's files presented revealed the following: 1. Ten (10) files did not contain information for the family physician, 2. Ten (10) files did not contain information for the parents preferred hospital. Interview with the director revealed she was unable to locate the documents at the time of the survey.

1085 - Evacuation Plan

922 KAR 2:090. Section 5. Evacuation Plan.

(1) A licensed child-care center shall have a written evacuation plan in the event of a fire, natural disaster, or other threatening situation that may pose a health or safety hazard for a child in care in accordance with KRS 199.895.

#### Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, and interview, the child care center failed to maintain written documentation in accordance with regulatory requirements. Review of presented documentation revealed the child care center had an evacuation plan dated 8/12/13. Interview with the director revealed there was an updated evacuation plan; however she did not locate the updated evacuation plan at the time of the survey.

## 1115 - Earthquake/Tornado Drills

922 KAR 2:110. Section 3. Records.

#### (1) A child-care center shall maintain:

(h) A written record of quarterly practiced earthquake drills and tornado drills detailing the date, time, and children who participated in accordance with 922 KAR 2:120, Section 3;

## Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, and interview, the child care center failed to maintain written documentation in accordance with regulatory requirements. Review of the presented earthquake and tornado drill form revealed there was no written documentation of earthquake drills for the first, second and third quarters in 2016 including the date, time, and children who participated. Further review of the form revealed there was no written documentation of tornado drills for the second and third quarter in 2016 including the date, time, and children who participated. Interview with the director revealed the earthquake and tornado drills had been conducted but were not documented.

## 1120 - Fire Drills

922 KAR 2:110. Section 3. Records. (1) A child-care center shall maintain: (i) A written record of practiced fire drills conducted monthly detailing the date, time, and children who participated in accordance with 922 KAR 2:120, Section 3;

## **Findings:**

General: Based on Review of Documentation, and interview, the child care center failed to maintain written documentation in accordance with regulatory requirements. Review of the fire drill form revealed the child care center did not present written documentation for fire drills conducted for January, February, March, April, September, and October 2016 including the date, time, and children who participated. Interview with the director revealed the fire drills had been conducted but were not documented.
