120 - Adequate Adults/Qualified Staff

(10) The minimum number of adult workers in a child-care center shall be sufficient to ensure that:

(a) Minimum staff-to-child ratios in accordance with 922 KAR 2:120 are followed;

(b) Each staff person under eighteen (18) years of age and each student trainee are under the direct supervision of a qualified staff person who meets the requirements of this section; and

(c) Unless providing care with a qualified staff person, a person under the age of eighteen (18) shall not be counted as staff for the staff-to-child ratio.

Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation such as attendance records, it was determined that three classrooms (infant one, infant two, and toddler one) were over ratio on numerous dates at various times. Some of these classrooms were also over group size. It was discovered through interview that at these times, the facility did not have an adequate amount of qualified staff members for coverage when the rooms were over ratio.

#### Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation such as attendance records, it was determined that there were numerous times that the infant one and two classrooms, as well as the toddler one classroom were over ratio and over the maximum group size. Upon review of attendance records, it was found that there were seven days when the infant one classroom was over group size and ratio. On these days, the number of infants varied from 11 to 14 at any given time; therefore, not meeting the maximum of 10 infants per group. When reviewing the attendance records for the infant two classroom, it was found that there was no documentation indicating that the class was over group size; however, it was found that at certain times throughout the day, there would be up to nine children in the classroom. The attendance records did not indicate what teachers were present and at what time they arrived. Interviews with the infant two teachers indicated that there own as over ratio at times and had too many children with only one teacher present. Upon review of attendance records for the toddler one classroom, it was found that there were at least three days when this classroom was over group size and ratio by one child.
