Findings:	
General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The following was found:	
1. The kitchen contained two stained ceiling tiles and a small water stain in the overhead light cover.	
2. The boy's bathroom located adjacent to the Preschool Room contained a section of baseboard that was not properly attached to the wall behind the urinal.	
3. The bathroom adjacent to the Early Preschool Room contained a vent in the ceiling with a large accumulation of dust.	
4. The Toddler EPS Room contained an excessive amount of crayon marks on the side of the barn and on the yellow wall next to the barn.

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. Three children's files contained expired immunization certificates. All three of the children had been enrolled in excess of thirty days.
