Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulations. Review of staff files and ECE-TRIS report revealed documentation of fifteen (15) hours of cabinet approved training was not presented for review at the time of survey for two (2) staff members hired 3/11/15 and 9/22/14. Interview with director revealed this documentation was not on file at the time of survey.
