Due to the current declared public health emergency caused by the Novel Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19), licensed child care centers must operate under Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and public health guidelines, as mandated by 922 KAR 2:400E, to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, the child care center staff failed to comply with the regulatory requirements specific to the current pandemic as established in 922 KAR 2:405E. Observation revealed there was a wall separating two (2) classes that was created less than six (6) feet tall; that was not completely stable; made by small book racks and also created by shelving type furniture. An interview with the staff in charge confirmed the small wall was in place as described.
