- (b) Protect and assure the health, safety, and comfort of each child.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1.) A dust pan and broom in the Two-year-old Classroom's bathroom that was accessible to the children.
- 2.) Several coats were protruding from children's individual cubbies and touching one another in the 4-5 year-old classroom A.

This methods of storing promotes the spread of germs and bacteria.

275 - Abuse/Neglect Report Procedure

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The surveyor's review of the Employee Handbook found that Abuse/Neglect Reporting Procedure states: "...shall make a report to the Director and to appropriate authorities...". KRS 620.030 requires anyone who suspects child abuse or neglect to report these allegations to the cabinet or law enforcement.

- (1) The premises shall be:
- (a) Suitable for the purpose intended;
- (b) Kept clean and in good repair;

Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The surveyor found the following:

- 1.) Clutter in the corner of the 4-5 year-old Classroom B.
- 2.) Dirty bathroom door across from the 4-5 year-old Classroom B.
- 3.) Dirty step stool in the upstairs bathroom.
- 4.) Tape residue on the countertop that is accumulating dirt, clutter in the corner of the classroom, and a dirty trash can in the Three-year-old Classroom A.
- 5.) Dirty step stool in the bathroom across from Three-year-old Classroom A.
- 6.) Rusty paper towel dispenser in the Three-year-old Classroom B.
- 7.) Dirty sink in the 4-5 year-old Classroom A.

580 - Floors, Walls, Ceilings

(9) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, in good repair, and constructed to be easily cleaned.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1.) Sticky Velcro residue and a vertical crack on the wall in the 4-5 year-old Classroom B.
- 2.) Chipped paint on the baseboards in the Three-year-old Classroom B.

645 - Sink Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 10. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

- (3) A sink shall be:
- (a) Located in or immediately adjacent to toilet rooms;
- (b) Equipped with hot and cold running water that allows for hand washing;
- (c) Equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit;
- (d) Equipped with liquid soap;
- (e) Equipped with hand-drying blower or single use disposable hand drying material;
- (f) Equipped with an easily cleanable waste receptacle; and
- (g) Immediately adjacent to a changing area used for infants and toddlers.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found that water temperature in the downstairs boys' and girls' bathroom was 82°F.
