- (2) A current or prospective child care staff member shall be subject to background checks in accordance with Sections 4 and 5 of this administrative regulation at intervals pursuant to 45 C.F.R. 98.43(d).

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, one staff who is still enrolled in high school, did not have documentation of a Child Abuse/Neglect (CAN) check on file at the facility. The staff was present the day of inspection.

922 KAR 2:090. Section 9. Records.

- (1) A child-care center shall maintain:
- (e) A current personnel file for each child-care center staff person to include:
- 1. Name, address, date of birth, and date of employment;
- 2. Proof of educational qualifications;
- 3. Record of annual performance evaluation;
- 4. Documentation of compliance with tuberculosis screening in accordance with Section 11(1)(b) of this administrative regulation; and
- 5. The results of background checks conducted in accordance with 922 KAR 2:280;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, one staff who is a co-op student and still in high school, did not have a staff file at the facility the day of inspection. Therefore, no identifying information such as name, address, date of birth, and hire date could be determined.

400 - Educational Requirements

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (1) Child-care center staff:
- (a) Hired after January 1, 2009, who have supervisory power over a minor and are not enrolled in secondary education, shall have a:
- 1. High school diploma:
- 2. GED or qualifying documentation from a comparable educational entity; or
- 3. Commonwealth Child Care Credential as described in 922 KAR 2:250;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, five staff did not have proof of education on file at the facility. These staff members were hired on 3/16/22, 8/1/22, 8/29/22, and 8/19/21. The fifth staff did not have a staff file at the facility; therefore, the hire date could not be determined.

405 - TB Verification Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (1) Child-care center staff:
- (b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:
- 1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or
- 2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the following was found:

- 1.) One staff hired on 8/13/20, had not obtained negative TB results within the last two years. The document on file expired on 8/20/22.
- 2.) One staff hired on 3/16/22, did not have negative TB documentation on file.
- 3) One staff did not have negative TB documentation on file. This staff member did not have a staff file; therefore, the hire date could not be determined.

435 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.
- (17) A staff person's compliance with training requirements of this section shall be verified through the cabinet-designated database maintained pursuant to 922 KAR 2:240.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the following was found:

- 1.) Four staff did not complete the required 15 annual training hours for the 07/01/21 to 06/30/22 year. Hire dates for the staff are 9/15/15, 8/7/13, 9/3/08, and 8/13/20.
- 2.) One staff hired on 8/19/21, completed PAHT training on 8/16/17; however, did not renew the training due 8/16/22.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the boys bathroom downstairs did not have a cover over the lightbulbs. It could not be determined if the bulbs were shatterproof.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, one child enrolled on 6/6/22, did not have an up to date immunization certification on file at the facility. The certificate on file expired on 8/26/22.

1250 - Enrollment Information Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 9. Records.

- (1) A child-care center shall maintain:
- (b) A written record for each child:
- 1. Completed and signed by the child's parent;
- 2. Retained on file on the first day the child attends the child-care center; and
- 3. To contain:
- a. Identifying information about the child, which includes, at a minimum, the child's name, address, and date of birth;
- b. Contact information to enable a person in charge to contact the child's:
- (i) Parent at the parent's home or place of employment;
- (ii) Family physician; and
- (iii) Preferred hospital;
- The name of each person who is designated in writing to pick-up the child;
- d. The child's general health status and medical history including, if applicable:
- (i) Allergies;
- (ii) Restriction on the child's participation in activities with specific instructions from the child's parent or health professional; and
- (iii) Permission from the parent for third-party professional services in the child-care center;
- e. The name and phone number of each person to be contacted in an emergency involving or impacting the child;
- f. Authorization by the parent for the child-care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, four of the ten children's files did not have authorization to seek medical care in an emergency.

922 KAR 2:090. Section 5. Evacuation Plan.

(1) A licensed child-care center shall have a written evacuation plan in the event of a fire, natural disaster, or other threatening situation that may pose a health or safety hazard for a child in care in accordance with KRS 199.895 and 42 U.S.C. 9858c(c)(2)(U).

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, there was no evidence that the facility's emergency preparedness plan had been updated and submitted to the proper authority for review since 2020.

1280 - Professional Development

- (1) A child-care center shall maintain:
- (f) A written annual plan for child-care staff professional development;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, one staff hired on 8/19/21, did not have documentation of a professional development plan on file at the facility.

1300 - Orientation Procedure Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 2. Child Care Services.

(3)(b) The program shall include:

2. Written policy that states that the procedures that were taught at the orientation training shall be implemented by each child-care center staff member.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, there was no evidence of an orientation procedure for staff on file at the facility.

- (6) In addition to the posting requirement of KRS 199.898(3), a child-care center shall post the following in a conspicuous place and make available for public inspection:
- (a) The provider's preliminary or regular license;
- (b) Each statement of deficiency and civil penalty notice issued by the cabinet during the current licensure year;
- (c) Each plan of correction submitted by the child-care center to the cabinet during the current licensure year;
- (d) Information on the Kentucky Consumer Product Safety Program and the program's Web site as specified in KRS 199.897;
- (e) A description of services provided by the child-care center, including:
- 1. Current rates for child care; and
- 2. Each service charged separately and in addition to the basic rate for child care;
- (f) Minimum staff-to-child ratios and group size established in 922 KAR 2:120; and
- (g) Daily planned program.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the statement of deficiency and plan of correction from the previous re-licensure survey was not posted at the facility.

1320 - Disaster Course of Action

1330 - Diapering/Handwashing

- (j) A written plan and diagram outlining the course of action in the event of a natural or manmade disaster, posted in a prominent place;

Findings:

General: Based on observation, a written plan and diagram for disaster was not posted in a prominent place within the facility.

922 KAR 2:120. Section 12. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

(9) The proper methods of diapering and hand-washing shall be posted at each diaper changing area.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the following was found:

- 1.) The boys bathroom in the hall and the bathroom in the nursery room, did not have the handwashing procedures posted at the sinks.
- 2.) The boys bathroom downstairs did not have the diapering steps posted at or near the changing table.
