General: Based on observation, interview and review of documentation, there were seven (7) children, ages three-years to four-years, in room N-3, which was non-licensed space. Documentation and interview revealed the room was not licensed by the cabinet.

Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, a caregiver hired 07/20/15, did not have a TB skin test or physician statement on file.

410 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, a caregiver hired 07/20/15, and a caregiver hired 10/01/14, completed no hours of annual training. The director completed three (3) hours of annual training. The director completed her pediatric abusive head trauma training on 07/23/13, and 04/26/19; therefore, she did not complete this training within the five (5) year timeframe.

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, a bottle of Germ-X foaming solution was labeled "Keep out of reach of children". this bottle was on a table beside the children's toys in room N-3.

- (6) Medication, including refrigerated medication, shall be:
- (a) Stored in a separate and locked place, out of the reach of a child unless the medication is:
- 1. A first aid supply and is maintained in accordance with subsection (1) of this section;
- 2. Diaper cream, sunscreen, or toothpaste. Diaper cream, sunscreen, or toothpaste shall be inaccessible to a child;
- 3. An epinephrine auto-injector. A licensed child-care center shall comply with KRS 199.8951 and 311.646, including:
- a. An epinephrine auto-injector shall be inaccessible to a child;
- b. A child-care center shall have at least one (1) person onsite who has received training on the administration of an epinephrine auto-injector if the child-care center maintains an epinephrine auto-injector;
 - c. A child-care center shall seek emergency medical care for a child if an auto-injector is administered to the child; and
- d. A child-care center shall report to the child's parent and the cabinet in accordance with 922 KAR 2:090, Section 12(1)(b) if an epinephrine auto-injector is administered to a child; or
- 4. An emergency or rescue medication for a child in care, such as medication to respond to diabetic or asthmatic condition, as prescribed by the child's physician. Emergency or rescue medication shall be inaccessible to a child in care;
 - (b) Kept in the original bottle; and
 - (c) Properly labeled
- (7) Medication shall not be given to a child if the medication's expiration date has passed.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, a bottle of rubbing alcohol, two (2) sticks of sunscreen and five (5) bottles of sunscreen were on a shelf in an unlocked area in room A-3. These eight (8) medications were not labeled to indicate for whom each was intended. Two (2) packs of Alka Seltzer and two (2) bottles of rubbing alcohol were on a shelf in a unlocked area in room N-3. These four (4) medications were not labeled to indicate for whom each was intended.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, the evacuation plan was not updated by December 31st. The director stated she failed to update the plan for the year of 2018.
