General: Based on Observation, it was found that the walls in the Four (4) year-old classroom, had several areas of chipped paint and several stains on the wall where the trash can was located. It was found that there was chipped paint on the backside of the door going into the classroom. In the Three (3) year-old classroom there was observed to be several areas of chipped paint on the walls and black scuff marks on the door leading to the outside play area. It was found in the Two (2) year-old classroom there was a green and white carpet on the floor in front of the sink that concainted a substantial amount of dirt and debris. It was also found that in the Two (2) year-old classroom, the floor around the sink was stained and contained dirt and debris. It was found that in the School Age classroom there were several areas of chipped paint on the walls and stains going down the wall where the trash can was located. It was found that in the Young Toddler room there was observed to be several areas of chipped paint on the walls. It was also found that in both restrooms used by the children in the School Age classroom there was observed to be brown stains smeared on the walls. It was found that one of the doors to the restroom in the school age classroom was cracked and dented.
