Additionally, the director acknowledged that the document to verify the education of the aforementioned staff member was not in the file.

In the Four (4) Year-Old room, a toilet bowl cleaning spray, which was labeled "keep out of reach from children," was stored in an unlocked, ground-level cabinet, making the cleaning agent accessible to children. In addition, the director went to observe the area and acknowledged that the current storage area for the toilet bowl spray was accessible to children.

A current written annual plan for child care staff professional development was not presented for review at the time of survey for nine (9) staff members with the following dates of hire: 10/12/08, 7/1/09, 8/6/14, 10/29/15, 8/15/16, 8/15/16, 10/17/16, 11/14/16 and 10/12/18. In addition, the director revealed that professional development plans were not available for the aforementioned staff members at the time of survey.
