## 922 KAR 2:090. Section 8. General.

- (7) If a director, employee, volunteer, or any person with supervisory or disciplinary control over, or having unsupervised contact with a child in care is named as the alleged perpetrator in a child abuse or neglect report accepted by the cabinet in accordance with 922 KAR 1:330, the individual shall be removed from direct contact with a child in care:
- (a) For the duration of the assessment or investigation; and
- (b) Pending completion of the administrative appeal process for a cabinet substantiation of child abuse or neglect in accordance with 922 KAR 1:320 or 922 KAR 1:480.

## Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, the child care center failed to comply with regulatory requirements. Observation of the Preschool Room inside the portal on 11/13/19 revealed a staff member who was named as the alleged perpetrator in a child abuse or neglect report that was accepted by the cabinet in accordance with 922 KAR 1:330 working alone caring for nine (9) children ranging in age from four-years-old through five-years-old from 11:20am-1:03pm. Interview with the representative from Child Protective Services revealed that he went to the child care center on 10/31/19 and notified the center of the perpetrator.
