Review of presented staff files revealed two (2) staff members with the hire date 8/15/10 did not complete fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training. Review of the ECE TRIS report verified the training hours were not completed. Interview with the director revealed the two (2) staff members with the hire date 8/15/10 did not complete fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved training.
