- 1) Staff person hired on 01/20/2020 had documentation on file showing the status of the background check was still in process. This was also verified through the KARES report. This staff person was not present the day of the inspection.
- 2) Staff hired on 09/28/2020 had documentation on file showing the status of the background check was still in process. This was also verified through the KARES report. This staff person was not working with children the day of the inspection.

General: Based on review of documentation, the most current copy of the licensing regulations were not available for staff review. The licensing regulations on file were dated 2016.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, staff hired on 01/20/2020 did not have education documentation on file. This same deficiency was originally cited for this staff person on 10/13/2020 at the renewal inspection.

405 - TB Verification Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (1) Child-care center staff:
- (b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:
- 1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or
- 2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, staff hired on 09/28/2020 did not have written documentation on file from a health care professional stating that the staff person was free of active tuberculosis.

435 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and

General: Based on review of documentation, one (1) staff person had only eight (8) cabinet approved training hours on file. This information was verified through ECE-TRIS.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the laundry room door was opened when the surveyor completed a walkthrough of the facility. There were jugs of bleach found on the floor as well as on top of the dryer. There was also a bottle of Lysol surface cleaner and a jug of laundry detergent located on top of the dryer. These items were accessible to the children.
