- (c) Matches, cigarettes, lighters, and flammable liquids;
- (d) Plastic bags;
- (e) Litter and rubbish;
- (f) Bar soap; and

General: Based on Observation, it was found that the unlocked cabinet under the sink by the diaper changing station contained empty plastic bags.

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

- (20) An outdoor play area shall be:
- (d) Safe from foreseeable hazard;
- (e) Well drained;
- (f) Well maintained;
- (g) In good repair; and
- (h) Visible to staff at all times.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, it was found that the weed guard was pulled through the mulch, creating a tripping hazard. It was also found that six (6) pieces of rebar were sticking through the landscape timbers surrounding the playground.

695 - Protective Surface Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

- (21) A protective surface shall:
- (a) Be provided for outdoor play equipment used to:
- 1. Climb;
- 2. Swing; and
- 3. Slide; and
- (b) Have a fall zone equal to the height of the equipment.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, it was found that a three and a half feet tall climbing structure with slides had only one and a half feet of mulched area on one (1) side. The fall zone was not adequate for the height of the equipment.

General: Based on Observation, it was found that the built-in wooden seat on the front side of a wooden playhouse was broken, resulting in exposed screws and jagged boards. A wooden bench under the slide was also found to have a jagged board and exposed screws.

General: Based on Observation, it was found that a ten-month-old child was drinking a bottle while lying in a crib.

940 - Frozen Food Not In Compliance

- (5) Frozen food shall be:
- (a) Kept at a temperature of zero degrees Fahrenheit or below; and
- (b) Thawed:

Findings:

- 1. At refrigerator temperatures;
- 2. Under cool, potable running water;
- 3. As part of the cooking process; or
- 4. By another method in accordance with the Department of Public Health's food safety standards and permits, established in KRS Chapter

217.

General: Based on Observation, it was found that there was not a thermomether in the main freezer.

General: Based on Observation, it was found that the posted menu was only for the current day. A weekly menu was not prepared.
