- (7) Except in accordance with subsection (8) of this section, the following shall be inaccessible to a child in care:
- (a) Toxic cleaning supplies, poisons, and insecticides;
- (b) Knives and sharp objects;
- (c) Matches, cigarettes, lighters, and flammable liquids;
- (d) Plastic bags;
- (e) Litter and rubbish;
- (f) Bar soap; and
- (g) Personal belongings and medications of staff.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, two (2) adult pairs of sharp scissors were stored in the top drawer near the sink in the four and five year olds' room. Several plastic blue bags were stored unlocked in a drawer below the counter in the two year olds' room. A small roll of plastic trash bags and seven (7) wadded up plastic bags were stored on a shelf beside the sink in the four and five year olds' room. All of these items were accessible to children.

General: Based on Observation, two (2), eleven month old infants slept on a cot during rest time in the infants' room. A crib was not available for each of them.

General: Based on Review of Documentation and observation, five (5) children used highchairs that were missing safety straps in the younger one year olds' room. The manufacturer recommended to always secure child in the restraints.
